Numeracy Definition

Numeracy is a confidence and a competence in the application of mathematical skills in everyday situations.

Numeracy Features

Numeracy is a skill for life and pupils should be confident and competent in:

- Using and applying basic numerical skills
- Performing calculation and choosing when this is appropriate
- Using calculators and/or written methods of calculation, choosing where these are appropriate
- Using graphs, tables and charts
- Measuring and estimating
- Communicating using mathematical language in practical situations e.g. money, time, weight.

Numeracy Aims

Departments and subjects across the school will:

- Encourage the use of Numeracy as a transferable skill across the school curriculum
- Encourage enjoyment in the use of Numeracy skills
- Foster and support the development of the Numeracy features relevant to each subject/department.
